BOOK OF BOOKS/ WEEK 4

SCRIPTURE:

Hebrews 13:8

Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today and forever.

Genesis 32: 22- 31

Ask (brief):

- What word/words stands out to you from that verse?
- Why that word?

WARM-UP

These questions help students name what they just heard, not debate it.

- What moment, story, or line from the message is still sticking with you?
- What part of the message made you pause or lean in?
- What surprised you about the story of Jacob?

Discussion

- Why do you think the Bible includes stories that feel messy and uncomfortable?
- What did the story of Jacob show you about what God is like?
- How does knowing Jesus is the same “yesterday, today, and forever” change how you see the Old Testament?

TENSION

Ask:

- Where in your life does faith feel more like wrestling than confidence?
- What's something you've been holding onto God about, even though it still hurts?
- What part of your story feels unresolved right now?

Optional follow-up (only if the room is ready):

- What makes it tempting to let go instead of keep trusting?

⚠ Let them answer.

Don't fix it.

Connect it:

- Where do you see yourself right now wrestling with God, holding on with desperation, or trying to avoid the struggle altogether?
- What would it look like for you to keep holding on instead of letting go this week?

⚠ IMPORTANT:

Do not explain yet. Let the message answer this tension.

Close your group time with a short prayer:
