FALLEN KINGDOM/ WEEK 4

SCRIPTURE:

Read Micah 6 together

Micah 6:8

“Act justly, love mercy, and walk humbly with your God.”

Warm up

Use 2–3 max.

- Would you rather:
 - Help someone and no one knows
 - Or help someone and everyone sees it? Be honest
- Have you ever seen someone treated unfairly? What happened?
- If you could fix one problem at your school, what would it be?

Leader transition:

- There are a lot of things in the world that just aren't right... and we notice them.

DISCUSSION

Let's talk about the Bible.

IMicah 6:8 (NIV)

“Act justly, love mercy, and walk humbly with your God.”

Ask:

- Which part stands out to you most: justice, mercy, or humility?
- What do you think that verse is asking us to do?

TENSION

Ask these slowly. Let them answer from experience.

- Do you think one person can actually make a difference? Why or why not?
- Why do people sometimes ignore problems instead of helping?
- Have you ever wanted to help... but didn't?

Ask all three slowly:

- Act Justly:
 - What is one situation where you know something isn't right — and you could step in?
- Love Mercy:
 - Who is someone you need to show grace to instead of judgment?
- Walk Humbly:
 - What is one area where you need to stop controlling everything and trust God?

Leader-Owned Tension Statement

(Do NOT ask this as a question. Say it.)

“It's easy to see what's wrong... but it's harder to step in and do something about it.”

Connect it:

- What is one small way someone your age could help others?
- Why do you think God would want us to care about people?

LISTEN FOR THIS

Listen for how God calls us to live differently — not just believe differently.

SCRIPTURE:

READ AS A GROUP

READ MICAH 6 TOGETHER

“Act justly, love mercy, and walk humbly with your God.”

Ask about verse (brief):

- Which of these is hardest for you personally — and why?
- What would it actually look like to live this out in your daily life?

Optional follow-up:

- Which one do you tend to ignore the most?

Optional follow-up:

- Do we tend to respond like Isaiah... or avoid it?

These questions help students name what they just heard, not debate it.

- Which part stood out most — act justly, love mercy, or walk humbly?
- What part of the message felt most challenging?
- What example or story stuck with you?

TENSION

Ask:

- Where have you seen something wrong... and chosen to do nothing?
- Is there someone you struggle to show mercy toward?
- Where are you trying to stay in control instead of letting God lead?

Connect it:

Ask all three slowly:

- Act Justly:
 - What is one situation where you know something isn't right — and you could step in?
- Love Mercy:
 - Who is someone you need to show grace to instead of judgment?
- Walk Humbly:
 - What is one area where you need to stop controlling everything and trust God?

JOURNAL MOMENT (Optional)

Prompt:

“Where is God asking me to step in, show grace, or let go?”

IMPORTANT:

They don't need to share if they don't want to share.

PRAY

Close your group time with a short prayer:
